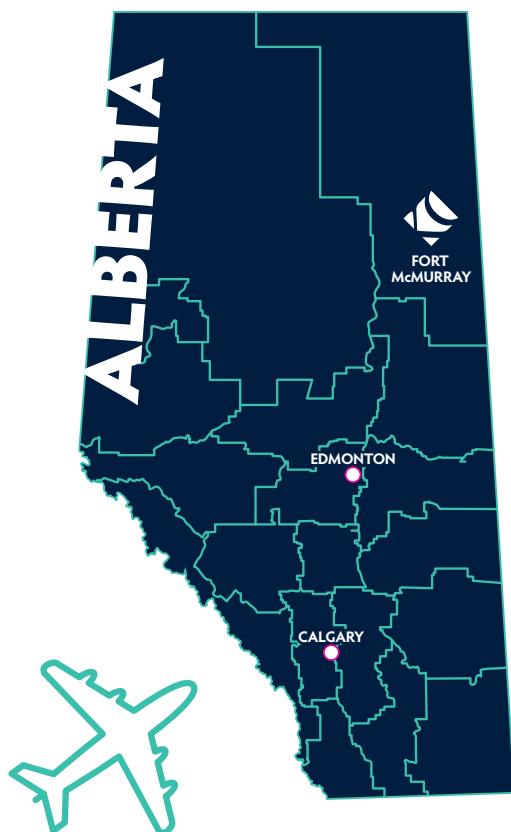

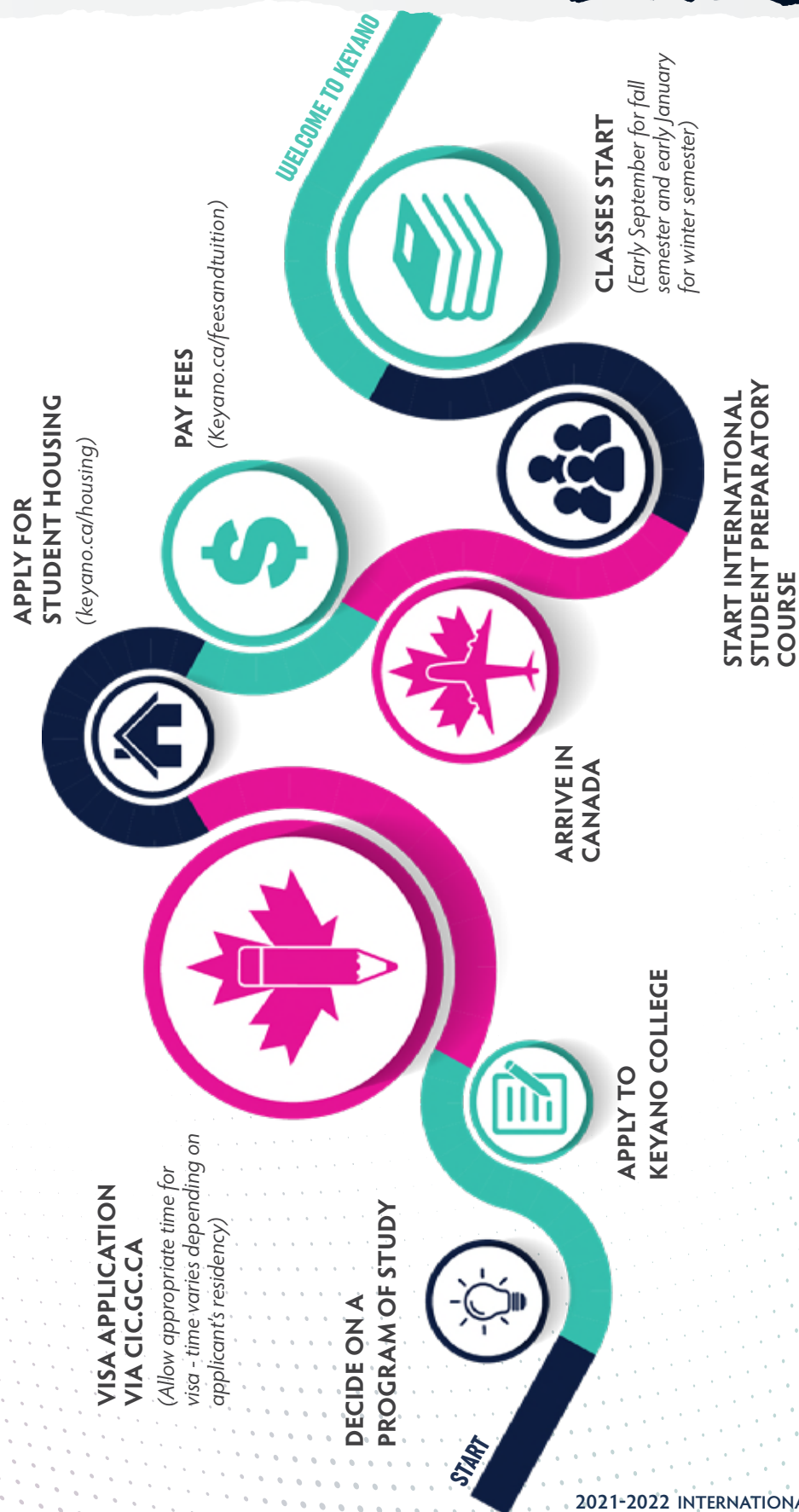
ACCESSIBILITY SERVICES

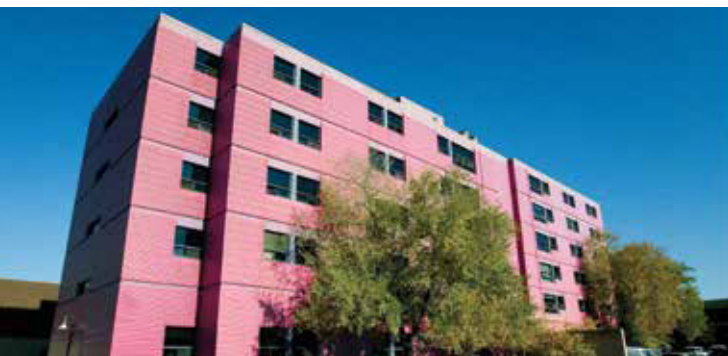

Steps to Apply:

1. Applications are submitted online through ApplyAlberta: **applyalberta.ca**
2. Under ApplyAlberta, choose Keyano College as your institution of choice.
3. Remember to include your primary e-mail address when submitting your application online for timely communication.
4. Applicants must pay a non-refundable application fee of \$107 (Canadian dollars) with a credit card to submit their application. If an applicant chooses to apply to more than one program, they must submit another application and application fee.
5. After you submit your application online, scan and email a copy of your transcript to admissions@keyano.ca. When sending your email, please include your first and last name, and your application ID or Keyano student ID (if you have been assigned one by our admissions office).
6. If you wish to authorize a third party to act on your behalf in transactions with Keyano College or have us release your information to a third party, you must complete the Third Party Authorization and Authorization for Release of Student Information forms, available here: **keyano.ca/en/student-services/forms.aspx**. Completed forms should be emailed to **registrar@keyano.ca**.
7.
